4. Technical limitations

7. Personal data management

In France, personal data is protected by the following laws and directives:

- Law No. 2004-801 of August 6, 2004

- Article L.226-13 of the French Penal Code
- The European Directive of October 24, 1995

During use of the site, the following data may be collected: the URL of links through which the user accessed the site, the user's ISP, and the user's IP address.

In any case, Lucky Bag only collects personal data for the purpose of certain services offered on the site. The user provides this information knowingly, particularly when entering it themselves. It is specified whether the information is mandatory.

In accordance with Articles 38 and following of Law 78-17 of January 6, 1978, any user has the right to access, rectify, and oppose the use of their personal data, by submitting a written and signed request with a copy of their ID, specifying the address to which the reply should be sent.

No personal information of the user is published, exchanged, transferred, or sold without their knowledge. Only the sale of Lucky Bag and its rights may allow the transfer of such information to a potential buyer, who would also be bound by the same obligations.

Databases are protected by the provisions of the Law of July 1, 1998, transposing Directive 96/9 of March 11, 1996, on the legal protection of databases.
